#4421 REPLACEMENT CDI CHIP INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING !!

Static electricity will damage electronic components!! Before touching the new chip or removing the CDI box cover be seated at a table and grounded so as not to generate any static electricity. One static spark will permanently damage you CDI box or chip.

1. Turn CDI box upside down and remove the four phillips screws. Remove aluminum plate and black plastic plate.
2. Before removing the programming chip observe it's proper location. With the CDI box positioned so that the chip is in the upper right hand corner notice that there is a notch in the chip facing to your left.
3. Very carefully remove the original chip. You may carefully use a flat bladed screwdriver if necessary to pry it out.
4. Install the new chip with the notch facing to the left as before. Be very careful to properly align all the pins and press down to seat the chip. Make sure all pins are in.
5. Replace the cover plates and screws and reinstall CDI box.
